


# Valencia/X-639 290T/A Year 8 ‘Pyramid Planting’

# Conclusions

- ▶ All rootstocks proved economically viable.
- ▶ Swingle and Sour Orange have obvious issues but under current management scenarios might warrant consideration as options.
- ▶ Density appears to be problematic at 290 t/a relative to crowding of US-802 and X-639.
- ▶ Hurricane impacted critical year 5 data to support 290 t/a vs. 220 t/a.
- ▶ This poor sample demonstrates the need for supervised grower based field trials with new generation and promising Phase 2 rootstocks.
